

CMS to initiate Accreditation Organization Direct Observation Validation Surveys

Resumption Effective Date: November 1, 2023.

Who's Conducting the Surveys?

- **DOV Surveys**: Conducted by CMS contractors: **Healthcare Management** Solutions, LLC (HMS) and Ascellon.
- **Expertise**: Contractors have experience pertinent to the service line observed, including **Home Health**, **Hospice**, and **Life Safety Code**.
- Exclusions: The process does not include DMEPOS or Home Infusion Therapy.

The Process and Phases

1. Initial DOVS Phase (first 3-6 months):

- CMS shared plans with AOs, including CHAP, on **October 19th**.
- CHAP and other AOs provide an **updated survey schedule**.
- DCACP selects targeted programs, focusing on reaccreditation surveys.
- 2. Continuation Phase (estimated 6 months-1 year)
 - The process continues with added **survey oversight resources**.

The Core Objective

- Aim: The AO oversight DOV survey ensures AOs, such as CHAP, survey in alignment with CMS's quality, safety standards, and procedures.
- **Observation**: CMS contractors will observe the AO but won't survey the agency directly.

What This Means for Your Agency

- **Survey Structure**: No change in your agency's survey process. CMS contractors will observe selected DOV surveys.
- DOV Survey vs. CHAP Surveys: CHAP's approach remains consistent, with Site Visitors leading the survey. This new process replaces previous CMS validation surveys done by **State agencies**. Instead, CMS contractors will observe the process.
- Announced Surveys: Surveys, be it for home health or hospice providers, will be **unannounced**. CHAP will know of the DOV survey initially. In the future, DOV surveys will be unannounced for everyone, with providers informed during the entrance conference.
